- An Antwerp win is less likely than a draw, the main alternative to a Club Brugge KV victory.

- Manchester City take more shots and allow fewer than most Premier League sides, supporting the away advantage.
- Yet Manchester United have won four of their last five at home, a reason for caution over Manchester City.
- Manchester City have won three of their last five away, with two wins against opponents in the bottom third at the time.
