- Settled tonight: level after ninety means extra time, and then penalties.
- Recent form favours the home side, two wins in five against one, yet the modelled result points away.
- Velez Sarsfield are the side more used to holding the ball, with Newells Old Boys typically seeing less of it.
- Newells Old Boys manage just eleven shots a game, among the fewest in the division.
- The case rests on the two-in-five home form; if the result split is truer, this reading flips.

31% Kolos Kovalivka **31%** draw **38%** Karpaty

- Kolos Kovalivka are expected to score 1.0 to Karpaty's 1.1 — likeliest 1–1.
- Kolos Kovalivka have kept four clean sheets in their last eight.
- Both of these defend well -- Kolos Kovalivka have conceded six goals in their last eight matches, Karpaty nine in their last 10.
- Karpaty collect cards at a rate above this division's; Kolos Kovalivka do not.

- Al-Dhafra have failed to keep a clean sheet in any of their last nine matches.
- Yet Al-Dhafra remain winless in five on the road, the clearest lean against them.

- Baniyas leak fifteen shots a game, well above the league norm.
- Khorfakkan only manage ten themselves, fewer than most sides here.
- But too many of the chances they concede come from close range.
- A tight low-scoring game looks likely, with a one-one finish the likeliest shout.

- 1º de Agosto lead the tie 2-0 from the first leg.
- 1º de Agosto carry the clearer threat, with Green Mamba expected to manage under one goal.
- Neither side has faced the other often, so this rests on form read through other opponents.
- If the game goes the other way, it likely stays goalless rather than swings away.

26% AS Sobemap 37% draw 37% Enugu Rangers

- Level after the first leg, 1-1.
- Neither side is expected to reach even a single goal on average, with nil-nil the likeliest score.
- With so few meetings between these two, this reading leans on form against other opponents rather than head to head.
- Where this goes wrong is an away win, the stated alternative to a draw.

- Al-Qadisiyah FC are expected to score 2.2 to Al-Ettifaq's 0.9 — likeliest 2–0.
- Al-Qadisiyah FC control games rather than trade them: more of the ball than most in this division, more shots, and fewer allowed.
- Against the call: Al-Ettifaq have won four of their last five on the road.
- Al-Ettifaq have won 4 of their last 5 away, but 3 of those wins came against opponents in the bottom third of the division at the time.

- JSK lead the tie 1-0 from the first leg.
- APR are expected to score 1.2 to JSK's 1.0 — likeliest 1–1.
- On this fixture these two rarely meet, so we are comparing them through other opponents rather than through each other.

Hafia v AC Douane

Hafia to go through 76%

very strong

59% Hafia **24%** draw **17%** AC Douane

- Level after the first leg, 2-2.
- With so little direct history between them, this is read through other opponents, not head to head.
- The gap between them is real but modest, pointing to a single-goal margin, likeliest one goal to nil.
- If Hafia are held, the more likely failure is a draw rather than an away win for AC Douane.

Réal Bamako to go through 90%

very strong

55% Réal Bamako **27%** draw **18%** Vitesse

- Réal Bamako lead the tie 2-1 from the first leg.
- Réal Bamako look set for a one goal to nil edge, a narrow home nose ahead rather than a rout.
- The two sides barely meet, so this reading leans on form against other opponents, not each other.
- The main danger to the home side is a draw, and most of that draw is goalless.

- The match outcome favours Al Wahda FC, but the attacking numbers point to Sharjah FC.
- Al Wahda FC face fewer shots than almost any side in the division, a defence hard to break down.
- Sharjah FC have won two of their last five away, though two of those came against struggling sides.
- If the attacking ratings are the truer guide here, it swings away from Al Wahda FC.

- A one-all scoreline looks the likeliest outcome here.
- Four wins from their last five at home shows a side that holds its own patch well.
- Two of Hannover's three away wins came against sides then in the bottom third.
- If result, attack, strength and form are wrong together, the case collapses with them.

- SV Darmstadt 98 are expected to score 1.8 to Arminia Bielefeld's 1.2 — likeliest 1–1.
- Against the call: SV Darmstadt 98 have not won any of their last five at home.
- Arminia Bielefeld have kept one clean sheet in their last 12.
- Arminia Bielefeld collect cards at a rate below the 2. Bundesliga's.

- AEL have the edge going forward here, with a scoreline around 1-1 the likeliest shape of things.
- Their defence is the concern: too many chances slip in from close range, and there's been no clean sheet in eight matches.
- The two sides haven't met enough at this level for history to carry any weight.

very strong

73% Beşiktaş 19% draw 8% Erzurumspor

- Beşiktaş are expected to score two goals to Erzurumspor's well under one — the gap is wide.
- Set against that, availability tilts slightly away from Beşiktaş, with a touch of their attack missing.
- The edge comes from control: twenty shots a game, more than most in the Süper Lig.
- What keeps this open is a draw, not an upset — that's the main alternative if the home side falters.

- The likeliest score sits at one-all, hardly the mark of a side pulling clear.
- Seven corners a game shows a side that camps in the final third, though territory alone doesn't decide games.
- The margin is one goal wide, so a single Arezzo strike turns this reading on its head.
- These sides haven't met enough at this level for history to back up either view.

66% FC Copenhagen 19% draw 14% AC Horsens

- FC Copenhagen are expected to score 2.3 to AC Horsens's 1.0 — likeliest 2–1.
- FC Copenhagen have won five of their last five at home.
- On this fixture these clubs have not played enough at this level for the record to tell us much.
- FC Copenhagen have won 5 of their last 5 at home, but 4 of those wins came against opponents in the bottom third of the division at the time.

75% AZ Alkmaar **17%** draw **8%** Willem II

- AZ Alkmaar are without Smit, Resink and one other, a real dent to their attack.
- That absence hits a real slice of the home attack, against a smaller share of Willem II's.
- Even thinned out, AZ are expected to score two and a half against Willem II's well under one.
- If the missing men are felt, the more likely slip is toward a draw, not a Willem II win.

74% Al-Ahli Jeddah **17%** draw **9%** Al-Hazm

- The gap starts at the other end: Al-Ahli Jeddah concede fewer shots than nearly anyone in the league.
- That control has held at home, where five wins from five have followed.
- Seven clean sheets in twelve matches show the defensive base behind the attacking numbers.
- If the goals do not come, the pattern points to a draw rather than an away win.

clear

56% Burgos **26%** draw **18%** AD Ceuta FC

- The likeliest scoreline sits at one goal to nil for Burgos, a narrow edge, not a rout.
- AD Ceuta manage only nine shots a game, so Burgos are not being tested hard, nor overwhelming them.
- Six clean sheets in twelve shows a defence that is often tight, but not always watertight.
- If Burgos fail to convert their edge, the likelier slip is a draw rather than an away win.

44% Union Berlin 32% draw 24% Schalke

- Union Berlin are expected to score 1.2 to Schalke's 0.8 — likeliest 1–0.
- Schalke give up chances from close in: a bigger share of the shots they face come from inside the box than most here.
- Union Berlin are without Ilic, Burke and three others — a big hole in their attack — already in the figures above.
- Schalke give up 11 shots a game, fewer than most in the 2. Bundesliga.

- Recent form favours the home side, but the attacking numbers point the other way.
- Our analysis makes it close between the two sides, with a 1-1 the likeliest single score.
- Anderlecht arrive without a win in five on the road, the strongest case against them.
- If this goes wrong, it likely fails toward a home win rather than a draw.

- Rennes have won four of their last five at home.
- A tight scoreline looks likely, something like one goal apiece.
- Marseille get through 14 shots a game, more than most in Ligue 1.
- Rennes win seven corners a game, more than most in Ligue 1.
- If Rennes don't win it, Marseille look more likely to nick it than a draw.

- Venezia control games rather than trade them: more of the ball than most in this division, more shots, and fewer allowed.
- Venezia have kept six clean sheets in their last 12.
- Venezia get 20 shots a game, more than most in Serie B.

- On this fixture these clubs have not played enough at this level for the record to tell us much.
- Hellas Verona have kept one clean sheet in their last 12.
- Hellas Verona have had less of the ball than most in Serie A.

- Result, attack, strength and form all read the same way here.
- The likeliest scoreline is a bare one-nil, not a rout.
- The main danger to the case is a draw, not an Entella win.
- A run of five without an away win is a fragile shield if Pisa move ahead.

48% Sevilla 27% draw 25% Valencia

- Rioja, Sadiq and four others missing leave Valencia's attack thin before a ball is kicked.
- Sevilla are likeliest to score one to Valencia's nought, the gap already built with those gaps in mind.
- Result, attack, strength, form and availability all read the same way here.
- One clean sheet in twelve says Sevilla can be got at, whatever the shape of the rest.

- Our numbers make this a likely one-goal game, West Ham's expected edge is thin.
- Availability actually favours Wrexham, with less of their attack missing than West Ham's.
- Wrexham concede only eleven shots a game, among the fewest in the Championship.
- One goal either way is enough to turn this reading on its head.
